2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 ACCEPTING A DONATION IN THE AMOUNT OF TEN
5 THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000), FROM BEST FRIENDS
6 ANIMAL SOCIETY TO THE ANIMAL CARE AND ADOPTION
7 DIVISION FOR FREE MICROCHIP, WELLNESS CLINIC
8 SERVICES, PET HOUSING, FOOD, COLLARS, LEASHES,
9 ID TAGS, AND BEHAVIOR INFORMATION TO PET
10 OWNERS IN UNDERSERVED COMMUNITIES IN
11 BROWARD COUNTY; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY
12 ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND
13 BUDGETARY ACTIONS TO IMPLEMENT ACCEPTANCE;
14 AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN
15 EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 WHEREAS, Best Friends Animal Society has donated to the Animal Care and
17 Adoption Division the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), to be used for free
18 microchip, wellness clinic services, pet housing, food, collars, leashes, ID tags, and
19 behavior information to pet owners in underserved communities in Broward County;

20 WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code provides
21 for the acceptance and acknowledgement by the Board of County Commissioners of
22 Broward County, Florida ("Board"), of donations to the County that are valued at
23 Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) or more; and

24 WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept the generous gift and express its gratitude
for the donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby accepts the donation from Best Friends Animal
Society, in the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), to be deposited in the Animal
Care Trust Fund and used for free microchip, wellness clinic services, pet housing, food,

1 collars, leashes, ID tags, and behavior information to pet owners in underserved
2 communities in Broward County.

3 Section 2. The County Administrator is hereby authorized to take all
4 administrative and budgetary actions and execute all forms required to implement
5 acceptance of the donation.

6 Section 3. Severability.

7 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
8 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
9 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be
10 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
11 determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,
12 group, entity, property, or circumstance.

13 Section 4. Effective Date.

14 This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
