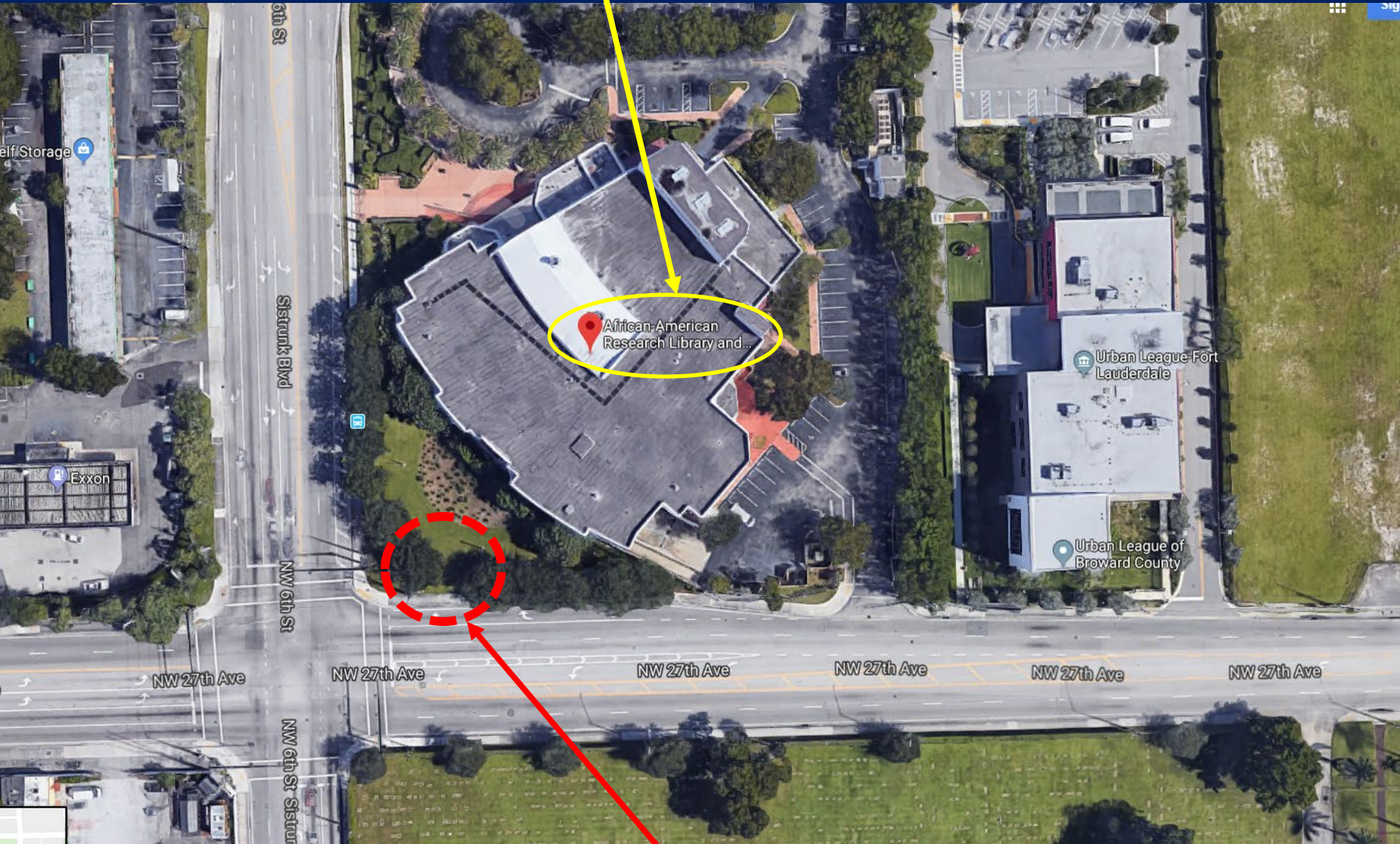

- Reference West African traditions of the linguist staff, ornamental hairpin, Adinkra symbols and Kente cloth color meanings through the sculptures' form, shape, color and pattern
