The Claimant is a 37-year-old Utilities Mechanic, with Broward County Water & Wastewater Services Division. On July 22, 2018, the Claimant alleged injuries to the head and brain due to a rollover motor vehicle accident. The accident was accepted as compensable under Florida Workers' Compensation Law.

The Risk Management Division recommends a settlement of up to \$65,000 which is in the best interest of Broward County.
