

SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND THE SEVENTEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT IN AND FOR BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA

This is the Second Amendment to the Agreement between Broward County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida ("County"), and the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit, a State Courts System entity ("Recipient"). The County and Recipient are collectively referred to as "the Parties."

RECITALS

- A. On February 28, 2017, the Parties entered into an Agreement whereby County provided funds to Recipient to subsidize the cost to program participants in Recipient's Misdemeanor Drug Court Program.
- B. On September 26, 2018, the Parties entered into a First Amendment to the Agreement pursuant to which unspent Allocated Funds would be transferred into subsequent fiscal years until the Allocated Funds are spent.
- C. The Parties now wish to amend Exhibit A to the Agreement to provide that program participants need only attend one class instead of the previously mandated two classes.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

AMENDMENT

- 1. The recitals set forth above are true, accurate, and fully incorporated by reference.
- 2. Exhibit A is amended to read as follows (stricken through language indicates deletions, whereas bold and underlining indicate additions; except as to paragraph headings that were bolded and underlined in the Scope of Work):

<u>Exhibit A</u> MISDEMEANOR DRUG COURT PROGRAM (MDCP) – SCOPE OF WORK

PURPOSE

DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE PROGRAM AND COSTS OF ATTENDANCE

[. . .]

EDUCATION: Participants must successfully complete two (2) the educational classes: Back to Basics which has a cost of attendance of \$50, and Justice for Life, which has a cost of attendance of costs \$100. Spanish speakers may instead attend the Spanish class offered by the Broward Dade Safety Council, which costs \$75. Out-of-County residents may attend an eight-hour online class for \$145, which class is available at www.druged101.com.

The Recipient will use the funds to subsidize the cost of substance abuse education courses so that program participants are only required to pay the following fees:

- \$25.00 for Back to Basics;
- \$75.00 for Justice for Life;
- \$50.00 for Spanish speakers to attend the Spanish class offered by the Broward Dade Safety Council; and 120.00 for our-of-county residents to attend an online course at www.druged101.com.
- 3. Effective Date: This Second Amendment will become effective upon execution.
