ORDINANCE NO. 2019-

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO TREE MAINTENANCE; AMENDING CHAPTERS 8½, 27, AND 39 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES ("CODE") TO DELETE VIOLATIONS RELATED TO TREE MAINTENANCE AND TO REPEAL SUNSETTED PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

(Sponsored by Commissioner Barbara Sharief)

WHEREAS, on May 8, 2018, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County enacted Ordinance No. 2018-22 ("Ordinance");

WHEREAS, the Ordinance eliminated County restrictions on the removal of trees planted an unsafe distance from power lines; imposed penalties (effective upon enactment) for property owners in the County's unincorporated areas that plant trees an unsafe distance from power lines; imposed penalties (effective one (1) year after the Ordinance's effective date) for property owners in the County's unincorporated areas that fail to maintain previously existing trees that had been planted an unsafe distance from power lines; and established temporary, one (1) year County-run programs to decrease the burden on property owners that may be required to maintain previously existing trees; and

WHEREAS, as a result of further research showing it would be overburdensome for property owners to maintain existing trees and because the temporary programs established in the Ordinance have expired, the Board finds it is in the public interest to repeal both the penalties for failing to maintain trees and the provisions that have expired,

22 amended to read as follows:

23 **Sec. 27-413. Tree preservation trust fund.**

2 (1) ~~Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this section, private property~~
3 ~~owners in the unincorporated areas of the County may apply for funds within~~
4 ~~the Broward County Tree Preservation Trust Fund to be used for remedial~~
5 ~~pruning or tree removal that may be required by Section 39-1381 of the~~
6 ~~Code.~~

7 (2) ~~To receive funds pursuant to this subsection, a private property owner shall~~
8 ~~meet the following requirements:~~

9 a. ~~The property owner must submit an application to EPGMD that~~
10 ~~certifies:~~

11 1. ~~The private property owner is the owner of private, residential~~
12 ~~property upon which the tree is located;~~

13 2. ~~The tree does not comply with the Right Tree, Right Place~~
14 ~~Guidelines; and~~

7 (3) ~~The Director may approve expenditures up to One Thousand Dollars~~
8 ~~(\$1,000) per tree or the cost of remedial pruning or removal of the tree,~~
9 ~~whichever is less. The Director shall deny any funding request that does~~
10 ~~not adhere to the requirements of this section, is determined to be~~
11 ~~fraudulent or otherwise unlawful, or where there are insufficient funds in the~~
12 ~~Tree Preservation Trust Fund.~~

13 (4) ~~Section 27-413(g) shall sunset one (1) year after the effective date of this~~
14 ~~ordinance.~~

15 Section 3. Section 39-131 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances is hereby
16 amended to read as follows:

17 **Sec. 39-131. Definitions.**

18 In addition to the terms defined in Article II of this chapter, the following words,
19 terms, and phases, when used in this article, shall have the following meanings, except
20 where the context clearly indicates a different meaning.

22 ~~*Remedial pruning:* The cutting and trimming of branches and foliage so as to~~
23 ~~alleviate the danger of the tree damaging power lines, consulting with American Natural~~
24 ~~Standards Institute ("ANSI") A300 (Part I) 2001 Pruning Standards, as amended, and~~

4 Section 4. Section 39-134 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances is hereby
5 amended to read as follows:

6 **Sec. 39-134. Procedure for violations; notices.**

7 . . .

8 (e) *Trees Maintenance Near Utilities.* Whenever a code enforcement officer
9 ascertains that a tree is not planted ~~or maintained~~ in compliance with this article, the
10 officer shall provide notice to the owner of the real property upon which the tree is located,
11 as determined in accordance with the tax rolls of Broward County, unless the enforcement
12 officer has actual knowledge of a subsequent property owner.

13 . . .

14 Section 5. Section 39-138.1 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances is
15 hereby amended to read as follows:

16 **Sec. 39-138.1 ~~Tree maintenance~~ Planting trees near utilities.**

17 (a) The intent of this section is to ~~require property owners to maintain trees~~
18 prohibit property owners from planting trees an unsafe distance from power lines in order
19 to minimize damage to power lines.

20 . . .

21 (e) ~~Any tree that is planted prior to the effective date of this ordinance and that~~
22 ~~is not in conformity with the Right Tree, Right Place Guidelines shall be required to~~
23 ~~undergo remedial pruning. The property owner shall be responsible for ensuring the tree~~

1 ~~remains in compliance with this section. Upon receipt of a notice of violation, the property~~
2 ~~owner shall have thirty (30) days to remedy the violation.~~

3 (1) ~~All tree trimming or remedial pruning shall be conducted by a contractor with~~
4 ~~a Class A Tree Trimmer License pursuant to Chapter 9, Article XI.~~

5 (2) ~~If remedial pruning cannot be successfully performed without removing~~
6 ~~more than twenty percent (20%) of the tree's canopy and the property owner~~
7 ~~does not relocate, replace, or remove the offending tree, the property owner~~
8 ~~shall remove twenty (20%) of the tree's canopy and must notify the owner~~
9 ~~of the power line in writing that the tree does not conform to this section and~~
10 ~~cannot be remedied through remedial pruning. Successful performance of~~
11 ~~remedial pruning under this part shall mean removal of any part of any tree~~
12 ~~within twenty (20) feet of any power line.~~

13 (3) ~~If an electrical utility company has performed trimming or pruning activity on~~
14 ~~the property owner's property within the last six (6) months, then this fact~~
15 ~~shall constitute a defense to any action taken against the property owner~~
16 ~~for failure to comply with subsection (c) above.~~

17 (d) ~~Any tree or other plant growth that is dead, severely diseased, or severely~~
18 ~~damaged and that is in danger of damaging any power line or has damaged a power line~~
19 ~~shall be cut down, destroyed, or removed by a contractor with a Class A Tree Trimmer~~
20 ~~License. Upon receipt of a notice of violation, the property owner shall have twenty (20)~~
21 ~~days to remedy the violation. If after twenty (20) days the violation has not been~~
22 ~~remedied, the County may remove the offending tree and shall place a lien on the property~~
23 ~~in the amount of the removal cost. The County shall have the authority to immediately~~

1 ~~remove any dead, severely diseased, or damaged tree and shall place a lien on the~~
2 ~~property in the amount of the removal cost if:~~

3 ~~(1) The tree presents an imminent danger to safety, property, or utilities; and~~

4 ~~(2) The County Administrator has suspended compliance with~~
5 ~~Chapter 27, Article XIV, of the Code pursuant to Section 27-406 of the~~
6 ~~Code.~~

7 ~~(e)~~ (c) A property owner within a homeowners' association, as defined in
8 Section 720.301, Florida Statutes, or a unit owner of a condominium association, as
9 defined ~~by~~ in Section 718.103, Florida Statutes, shall not be deemed to have violated any
10 part of this section where compliance would conflict with the Declaration of Restrictive
11 Covenants, by-laws, or regulations of the homeowners' association or condominium
12 association or where the homeowners' association or condominium association has
13 undertaken to ~~maintain~~ plant trees and other plant growth. The code enforcement officer
14 or hearing officer, as applicable, shall dismiss any notice of violation upon the showing of
15 said conflict. Where the homeowners' association or condominium association has
16 undertaken to ~~maintain~~ plant trees and other plant growth, the homeowners' association
17 or condominium association, as applicable, shall be deemed the responsible party for
18 purposes of compliance with this section.

19 ~~(f)~~ (d) Unless otherwise specified in this section, property owners subject to an
20 enforcement action shall receive a notice of violation in accordance with Section 39-134
21 prior to any action being taken against them and may appeal the decision pursuant to
22 Chapter 8½ of the Code prior to the time limit to remedy the violation.

1 ~~(g)~~ (e) Any person who violates the requirements set forth in this section shall be
2 subject to fines as set forth in Section 8½-16(a) of the Code. Each incident involving each
3 tree shall be considered a separate violation of this article.

4 ~~(h)~~ Except for subsection ~~(b)~~, which shall become immediately effective upon
5 enactment, the preceding sections shall become effective one ~~(1)~~ year after
6 enactment. Within one hundred and eighty ~~(180)~~ days after enactment of this ordinance,
7 the County shall complete a survey of the unincorporated areas to identify trees that are
8 not in compliance with this section. The location of noncompliant trees shall be
9 communicated to FP&L, which shall be given an opportunity to trim or remove the
10 offending trees consistent with applicable legal requirements. At ten ~~(10)~~ months
11 following the enactment of this ordinance, the County shall determine if additional pruning
12 or removal is required and may, with the property owner's permission, prune or remove
13 those trees identified in the survey as being noncompliant to bring those trees into
14 compliance with this section.

15 Section 6. Severability.

16 If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
17 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
18 Ordinance. If any court determines that this Ordinance, in whole or in part, cannot be
19 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
20 determination will not affect the applicability of this Ordinance to any other individual,
21 group, entity, property, or circumstance.

22 Section 7. Inclusion in the Broward County Code of Ordinances.

23 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this
24 Ordinance become part of the Broward County Code of Ordinances as of the effective
