10	desires to amend Section 23.7 of the Broward County Administrative Code, pertaining to

12	Section 23.9, pertaining to financial statements requirements, NOW, THEREFORE,

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17	Section 1. Section 23.7 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby		
18	amended to read as follows:

21	b. Subsequent to the Board's adoption of the resolution by the Board, each		
22	Organization accepting funding shall enter into a contract with Broward County, the form		
23	of which has been reviewed and approved by the Office of the County Attorney and		
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roved by the Board setting forth terms and conditions. Funding and shell contract roval of the shell contract shall be done through this resolution, which shall contain:

7. The County Administrator is authorized to execute any Amendments to contracts whereby the authority to the County Administrator to execute such has been provided for through the original approval process by way of a Resolution or a Contract previously approved by the Board.

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Section 2. Section 23.9 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby eted in its entirety:

9. Financial statements requirements Reserved.

Awards of less than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000). Except as otherwise vided by law and/or the provisions of any applicable contract(s) with the State of ida, the federal government or any other Organizations granting funds to the County he provision of applicable services. awards of less than Twenty-five Thousand Dollars: 5,000) may be used to assist an Organization in paying recurring operating expenses ociated with the routine operation and maintenance of a facility, such as utilities and phones, on a monthly basis, provided that individual invoices setting forth such costs are properly submitted to the County and approved for payment by the County.

- a. Financial Statements:
- 4 Application for Funding
 - Except as otherwise provided by law and/or the provisions of any (a) applicable contract(s) with the State of Florida, the federal

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government or any other Organizations granting funds to the County for the provision of applicable services, in lieu of audited financial statements, applicants/Organizations requesting less than Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) must submit:

- (1) The Organization's Federal Reporting Form #990 for the two
 (2) years immediately preceding the Application,
 accompanied by a signed statement from the Organization's
 Board of Directors/President certifying that submission of
 Federal Reporting Form #990 was timely and correctly filed
 and accepted by the Internal Revenue Service.
- (2) If the Organization is exempt from filing Federal Form 990, the Application must so state in separate letter to be included in the Application and must file the financial statements referenced in (3) below.
- (3) The applicant must submit financial statements that may be produced by the Organization for a minimum of two (2) years immediately preceding the Application, depending on Organization's history. At a minimum, the financial statements must include a Statement of Revenue, Expenses, and Changes in Fund Balances, Statement of Functional Expenses, and Balance Sheet. These financial statements must contain a signed statement by the Organization's Executive Director/President and the Chief Financial Officer

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that the financial statements accurately reflect/project the financial condition of the Organization.

- (b) Except as otherwise provided by law and/or the provisions of any applicable contract(s) with the State of Florida, the federal government or any other Organizations granting funds to the County for the provision of applicable services, Applicants/Organizations requesting funding of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) or more must submit a copy of the Organization's most recent audited financial statements with accompanying management letter, if any, to be included in each original and complete copy of the Application submitted.
- 2. Contract Execution: Except as otherwise provided by law and/or the provisions of any applicable contract(s) with the state of Florida, the federal government or any other Organizations granting funds to the County for the provision of applicable services, the following shall apply:
 - (a) In order to obtain execution of an agreement, recipients/Organizations of awards of less than Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) in any one (1) County fiscal year are required to submit financial statements signed in accordance with 1.(a)(3) above.
 - (b) In order to obtain execution of an agreement, recipients/Organizations of awards of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) or more in any one (1) County fiscal year are required to submit the Organization's most recent audited financial statements

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with accompanying management letter, if any to be included in each copy of the Application submitted.

- 3. Contract Compliance: Except as otherwise provided by law and/or the provisions of any applicable contract(s) with the State of Florida, the federal government or any other Organizations granting funds to the County for the provision of applicable services, the following shall apply:
 - (a) Recipients/Organizations of awards of less than Twenty-five Thousand (\$25,000) in any one (1) County fiscal year must file with County the financial statements referenced above within thirty (30) days after the expiration of an agreement.
 - (b) Recipients/Organizations of awards of Twenty-five Thousand 25,000) Dollars or more in any one (1) County fiscal year must submit annual audited financial statements with accompanying management letter, if any, within one-hundred twenty (120) days of the expiration of an agreement, pursuant to the terms stated in the executed agreement.
- 4. Except as otherwise provided by law and/or the provisions of any applicable contract(s) with the State of Florida, the federal government or any other Organizations granting funds to the County for the provision of applicable services, the Recipients/Organizations may not use County funds to purchase services resulting in audited financial statements.
- 5. Except as otherwise provided by law and/or the provisions of any applicable contract(s) with the State of Florida, the federal government or any other Organizations granting funds to the County for the provision of applicable

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services. the financial statements described above, if applicable, shall include a statement as to whether any funds, including interest earned on such funds, are due back to the County; and a statement that the funds received have been expended in accordance with the executed agreement.
