Re: PLAN AMENDMENT PC 19-3 – Changing Land Use Designation from Community to Commerce (Miramar)

As a registered home owner and tax paying constituent of Broward County and 18-year resident of Miramar Florida, this is my formal *written* notice registering my *opposition* regarding the captioned issue.

Several years ago, I personally asked incoming Mayor Wayne Messam what the designated use of the land would be since it was left vacant after Hurricane Wilma. I was told then, that it would house the Elder Day Care facility which is now in existence. I indicated then that residents of South Central Miramar (south of Miramar & west of Douglas), do not have a community park within a ½ to 1 mile radius that we can enjoy, and instead we have to rely on other parks in adjoining communities. While I understand the importance of investment; I do not appreciate and am very sad to see the over-commercialization of the City and County.

I do hope that my letter will be read at this week's hearing since I am not able to attend.
