## METHODOLOGICAL STATEMENT County Business Enterprise (CBE) Program

PROJECT TITLE: Energy Audit and Energy Performance Professional

**Consultant Services** 

**BASE GOAL**: Based on analysis of industry data and other relevant factors, the Broward County Business Opportunity Act of 2012 established a base goal of <u>25%</u>.

**APPROACH**: Weighted availability of CBE-eligible firms was based on scopes of work as identified by the using agency. The Project Manager has identified the breakdown of the scope of work for the project. All portions of the scope of work are included for purposes of assessing overall relative availability of CBE-eligible firms by NAICS code.

**DATA**: Data from OESBD database of CBE-certified firms and the 2011 County Business Patterns of the U.S. Census Bureau for Broward County firms relative to NAICS codes were used for this analysis.

**ADJUSTMENTS:** According to the Project Manager, the prime contractor/consultant can perform 100% of the scope of service for the first phase, which consists of an energy audit. The report resulting from the audit will establish scope of services for work to be performed for the second phase of the contract, which may provide for subcontracting in the areas of Engineering Services and Building Construction. Based on a review of a similar project, Energy Performance Project at Water and Wastewater Services (RLI No. R0728501R1) and on availability, a 10% participation goal is reasonable and achievable.
