RESOLUTION OF **BOARD** OF COUNTY THE **BROWARD** COMMISSIONERS OF COUNTY FLORIDA. COMMENDING AIRBNB, INC.'S ("AIRBNB") REVERSAL OF ITS PRIOR DECISION TO REMOVE LISTINGS OF RENTAL PROPERTIES LOCATED WITHIN ISRAELI SETTLEMENTS ESTABLISHED IN DISPUTED TERRITORY WITHIN THE WEST BANK; REVERSING THE BOARD'S PRIOR DECISION PROHIBIT REIMBURSEMENT OF ANY EMPLOYEE LODGING EXPENSES BOOKED THROUGH AIRBNB; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Israel is a strong and trusted ally of the United States;

WHEREAS, Broward County, which is part of a region that is home to one of the nation's and world's largest Jewish populations, shares democratic values and strategic interests with Israel and its people;

WHEREAS, Airbnb, Inc. ("Airbnb") is a privately held global company headquartered in San Francisco, California, that operates an online platform through which people can select lodging accommodations by choosing from among properties listed on the platform;

WHEREAS, in November 2018, Airbnb decided to remove from its platform all listings of rentals in Israeli settlements in the disputed area commonly known as the West Bank, while continuing to allow listings for properties in other portions of the disputed West Bank;

WHEREAS, Airbnb's policy singled out disputed territory affecting Israel and did not apply to other disputed territories around the world, including Northern Cyprus, Tibet, and Western Sahara;

WHEREAS, on January 29, 2019, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") enacted a resolution condemning Airbnb's discriminatory actions, prohibiting reimbursement for lodging expenses for County employees who book their lodging for public business travel through Airbnb, and encouraging the state and federal governments to penalize Airbnb for its decision to remove listings for rental properties within Israeli settlements established in disputed territories;

WHEREAS, as a result of Airbnb's actions, Florida Governor Ron DeSantis ordered that Airbnb be placed on Florida's list of scrutinized companies, thereby prohibiting the state and local governments from entering into certain agreements with Airbnb;

WHEREAS, Airbnb has since reversed its decision to remove listings of rental properties in Israeli settlements in the West Bank; and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to commend Airbnb on reversing this prior decision, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby commends Airbnb's decision to reverse its prior policy concerning the listing of properties within Israeli settlements in the West Bank.

Section 2. The Board hereby rescinds its prior decision to prohibit employee reimbursement for any lodging for public business travel booked through Airbnb.

1 Section 3. Severability. 2 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid 3 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be 4 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such 5 6 determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, 7 group, entity, property, or circumstance. 8 9 Section 4.
