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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
4 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
5 CONSENTING TO THE ASSIGNMENT OF A
6 NONEXCLUSIVE MARINE TERMINAL SECURITY
7 SERVICES FRANCHISE FROM ALLIEDBARTON
8 SECURITY SERVICES LLC TO UNIVERSAL PROTECTION
9 SERVICE, LLC, D/B/A ALLIED UNIVERSAL SECURITY
10 SERVICES TO PROVIDE MARINE TERMINAL SECURITY
11 SERVICES AT PORT EVERGLADES; AND PROVIDING
12 FOR NONDISCRIMINATION, COMPLIANCE WITH
13 APPLICABLE LAW, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE
14 DATE.

15 WHEREAS, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners (the "Board")
16 adopted Resolution No. 94-1302 creating Chapter 32 of the Broward County
17 Administrative Code, effective November 22, 1994, to provide for the regulation of
18 businesses requiring franchises to conduct operations at Port Everglades; and

19 WHEREAS, AlliedBarton Security Services LLC (Assignor) has submitted an
20 application for the assignment of its nonexclusive marine terminal security services
21 franchise to Universal Protection Service, LLC, d/b/a Allied Universal Security Services
22 (Assignee), and the Board has relied on the representations made by AlliedBarton
23 Security Services LLC and Universal Protection Service, LLC, d/b/a Allied Universal
24 Security Services, and reviewed the application in light of the requirements of Chapter 32
of the Broward County Administrative Code; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing required for this assignment of franchise was
conducted on June 6, 2017; and

1 WHEREAS, based on representations of Assignor and Assignee and information
2 presented by County staff and the public, the Board does hereby find, determine, and
3 declare the assignment of the nonexclusive franchise to be in the public interest, NOW,
4 THEREFORE,

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6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
7 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

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9 Section 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are true and correct and hereby
10 ratified by the Board of County Commissioners.

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12 Section 2. ASSIGNMENT OF FRANCHISE FROM ALLIEDBARTON
13 SECURITY SERVICES LLC TO UNIVERSAL PROTECTION SERVICE, LLC, D/B/A
14 ALLIED UNIVERSAL SECURITY SERVICES.

15 The Broward County Board of County Commissioners hereby consents to the
16 assignment of the nonexclusive marine terminal security services franchise from
17 AlliedBarton Security Services LLC to Universal Protection Service, LLC, d/b/a Allied
18 Universal Security Services.

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20 Section 3. TERM OF ASSIGNED FRANCHISE.

21 The term of the assigned nonexclusive marine terminal security services franchise
22 shall commence on the date this franchise assignment is approved by COUNTY, and
23 expire on December 31, 2019, unless sooner terminated in accordance with the
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1 provisions of the franchise, including Section 32.29 of the Broward County Administrative
2 Code.

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4 Section 4. NONDISCRIMINATION/APPLICABLE LAW.

5 By accepting this nonexclusive franchise, Universal Protection Service, LLC, d/b/a
6 Allied Universal Security Services (Assignee) agrees that the effectiveness is subject
7 to strict compliance with Broward County Human Rights Act (Chapter 16-½, Broward
8 County Code of Ordinances), and all rules, regulations, and ordinances, including the
9 Broward County Administrative Code and Code of Ordinances, now or hereafter
10 promulgated by Broward County pertaining to the conduct of the business operated
11 pursuant to this franchise, and is also subject to the terms and provisions of all federal
12 and state laws, as amended from time to time, affecting the conduct of the business for
13 which Universal Protection Service, LLC, d/b/a Allied Universal Security Services is
14 hereby franchised. The imposition and enforcement of such laws to which this franchise
15 shall be subject shall operate uniformly with respect to all persons, firms, or corporations
16 holding similar franchises within Port Everglades.

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18 Section 5. SEVERABILITY.

19 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the invalid
20 portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the remainder of
21 this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any portion hereof, cannot
22 be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), property(ies), or
23 circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability hereof to any other
24 individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

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Section 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
