2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,  
4 ACCEPTING A DONATION IN THE AMOUNT OF TWELVE  
5 THOUSAND SIXTY-EIGHT DOLLARS AND NINETY-SIX  
6 CENTS (\$12,068.96) FROM PET SUPERMARKET, INC., TO  
7 BE DEPOSITED IN THE ANIMAL CARE TRUST FUND FOR  
8 THE FUNDING OF FOSTER CARE PROGRAMS;  
9 AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE  
10 ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS TO  
11 IMPLEMENT ACCEPTANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR  
12 SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 WHEREAS, Pet Supermarket, Inc., located in Sunrise, Florida, has made a  
14 donation to the Animal Care and Adoption Division in the amount of Twelve Thousand  
15 Sixty-eight Dollars and Ninety-six Cents (\$12,068.96), to be used for the funding of foster  
16 care programs; and

17 WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code provides  
18 for the acceptance and acknowledgement by the Board of County Commissioners of  
19 Broward County, Florida ("Board"), of donations to the County that are valued at Five  
20 Hundred Dollars (\$500) or more; and

21 WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept the generous gift and express its gratitude  
22 for the donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby accepts the donation from Pet Supermarket, Inc.,  
in the amount of Twelve Thousand Sixty-eight Dollars and Ninety-six Cents (\$12,068.96),

1 to be deposited in the Animal Care Trust Fund and used for the funding of foster care  
2 programs of the Animal Care and Adoption Division.

3 Section 2. The County Administrator is hereby authorized to take all  
4 administrative and budgetary actions and execute all forms required to implement  
5 acceptance of the donation in this matter.

6 Section 3. SEVERABILITY.

7 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the invalid  
8 portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the remainder of  
9 this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any portion hereof, cannot  
10 be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), property(ies), or  
11 circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability hereof to any other  
12 individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

13 Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

14 This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
