FLORIDA. 3 QUITCLAIM DEED FOR ACCEPTING A RIGHT-OF-WAY OWNED BY THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, MEASURING 4 14,000 SQUARE FEET, AND LOCATED IN POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN 5 EFFECTIVE DATE. 6 7 WHEREAS, the City of Pompano Beach, a Florida municipal corporation ("City"), 8 owns title to certain real property pursuant to a plat dedication for a public right-of-way, 9 as recorded in Plat Book 34, Page 38, of the Public Records of Broward County, Florida 10 ("Property"), which Property is more particularly described in the legal description and 11 sketch within the quitclaim deed, attached hereto and made a part hereof as 12 Attachment 1 ("Quitclaim Deed"); and 13 WHEREAS, the Property is adjacent to the Broward County Water and 14 Wastewater Services treatment plant located at 1390 NE 50th Street, Pompano Beach, 15 16 Florida 33309 ("Plant"); and 17 18 WHEREAS, Broward County ("County") desires to acquire the Property for the 19 purpose of a right-of-way, and to enhance the security and safety of the Plant; and 20 21 WHEREAS, Section 335.0415, Florida Statutes, provides that public roads, with 22 the mutual agreement of the affected governmental entities, may be transferred 23 between jurisdictions; and

1 WHEREAS, on January 23, 2018, the City Commission of the City of Pompano 2 Beach adopted Resolution No. 2018-71, which approved the conveyance of the 3 Property to the County and authorized the execution of the Quitclaim Deed; and 4 5 WHEREAS, pursuant to the City Resolution No. 2018-71, the City conveyed the Property to the County via the Quitclaim Deed, recorded on February 8, 2018, as 6 7 Instrument Number 114879086, in the Public Records of Broward County, Florida; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida 10 ("Board"), has determined that acceptance of the Quitclaim Deed serves a public 11 purpose and is in the best interest of the County, NOW, THEREFORE, 12 13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF 14 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA: 15 16 Section 1. The recitals set forth in the preamble to this Resolution are true, 17 accurate, and incorporated by reference herein as though set forth in full hereunder. 18 19 Section 2. The Board hereby accepts the Quitclaim Deed attached as 20 Attachment 1. 21 22 Section 3. SEVERABILITY. 23 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the 24 invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the

#### **QUIT CLAIM DEED**

CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, a municipal corporation of the County of Broward, State of Florida, whose post office address is 100 W. Atlantic Boulevard, P. O. Box 2083, Pompano Beach, Florida 33061, referred to as "first party," to

BROWARD COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, whose post office address is 115 South Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301, hereinafter referred to as "second party."

(Wherever used herein the terms "first party" and "second party" shall include singular and plural, heirs, legal representatives and assigns of individuals, and the successors and assigns of corporations, wherever the context so admits or requires.)

WITNESSETH, that the said first party, for and in consideration of the sum of TEN and No/100 DOLLARS (\$10.00) in hand paid by the second party, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby remise, release and quit-claim unto the said second party forever, all the right, title, interest, claim and demand which the said first party has in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the County of Broward, State of Florida, to-wit:

### SEE LEGAL DESCRIPTION ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF AS EXHIBIT "A"

- (h) Transfer to governmental agencies. The City of Pompano Beach may sell or transfer any of its property to any other governmental agency, if the City Commission finds that:
- (1) A transfer of the property to the other governmental agency shall provide a benefit to the City of Pompano Beach; and

The County's Water and Wastewater Services plant provides freshwater to the City's residents and, as such, it is in the City's best interest to ensure that the safety of the subject facility.

(2) That a transfer to any other party other than that governmental agency would not provide the same benefit to the people of Pompano Beach; and The adjacent County's Water and Wastewater Services plant provides freshwater to the City's residents in that area, no one else is providing water service to the City's residents in that area, and the ROW being requested is too small to be utilized by any other party for any recognizable benefit

(3) That the compensation to be received by the City of Pompano Beach is fair and equitable; and

This Charter Section provides the City discretion to sell or transfer the property. In this case, the City does not want to require the County to pay any money for this ROW since we are receiving in kind benefits pursuant to the County's provision of freshwater to our residents in this area plus the conveyance will relieve the City from having to maintain the property as well as legal responsibility for same.

(4) That the governmental agency to which the land is being transferred would in any event have the power of eminent domain over said property. The procedure of public notice shall apply.

The County has the right to initiate eminent domain proceedings for this piece of ROW.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same together with all and singular the appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest, lien, equity and claim whatsoever of said first party, either in law or equity, to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of said second party forever.





# CITY OF POMPANO BEACH Broward County, Florida

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, FINDING THAT THE CITY'S CONVEYANCE OF RIGHT-OF-WAY ALONG A PORTION OF NE 51<sup>ST</sup> STREET TO BROWARD COUNTY SATISFIES THE CRITERIA OF SECTION 253 OF THE CITY'S CHARTER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Pompano Beach owns a 70' wide by 200' long portion of right-of-way along NE 51st Street adjacent to Broward County's Water and Wastewater Services Plant located at 1390 NE 50th Street; and

WHEREAS, Broward County has requested the City of Pompano Beach convey the foregoing right-of-way along NE 51<sup>st</sup> Street to the County to enhance the security and safety of its Water and Wastewater Services Plant and nearby City residents; and

WHEREAS, Section 253 of the City's Charter provides the City may sell or transfer any of its property to another governmental agency if the four specific criteria as set forth below are satisfied; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that the proposed transfer to Broward County provides a benefit to the City of Pompano Beach insofar as the Water and Wastewater Services Plant provides freshwater to the City's residents in the area; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that a transfer to any other party than Broward County would not provide the same benefit to the people of Pompano Beach because only the County's Water and Wastewater Services Plant provides freshwater to the City's residents in that area; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds the in-kind compensation to be received by the City of Pompano Beach in exchange for the subject conveyance is fair and equitable because the

County's Water and Wastewater Services Plant provides freshwater to the City's residents in that area, the property being transferred is too small to be utilized by another other party for development or any cognizable use and it will eliminate potential liability and maintenance costs associated with this currently unused property; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission finds Broward County has the power of eminent domain over the subject property; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

**SECTION 1.** That a Quit Claim Deed by the City of Pompano Beach to Broward County, a copy of which Quit Claim Deed is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as if set forth in full, is hereby approved.

**SECTION 2.** That the proper City officials are hereby authorized to execute said Quit Claim Deed by the City of Pompano Beach.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
