The firms were given three (3) business days to provide complete LOIs or documentation demonstrating their good faith efforts to meet the goal. Neither firm provided any LOIs or any documentation of good faith effort. Therefore, OESBD has determined that Ferguson Enterprises and Empire Pipe Orlando LLC are not in compliance with the CBE requirements for this solicitation based on Section 1.81-5 of the Broward County Business Opportunity Act of 2012.
