11	Section 1. Section 1-311 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances is hereby
12	amended to read as follows:
13	Sec. 1-311. Meetings; organization; and quorum.
14	
15	(d) A majority of the total appointed members of the MMAB shall constitute a
16	quorum. A simple majority of votes by the members present and constituting a quorum
17	shall be necessary in order to adopt any measure.
18	Section 2. <u>Severability</u> .
19	If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
20	portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of
21	this Ordinance. If any court determines that this Ordinance, in whole or in part, cannot
22	be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
23	determination will not affect the applicability of this Ordinance to any other individual,
24	group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Inclusion in the Broward County Code of Ordinances. 2 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of 3 this Ordinance become part of the Broward County Code of Ordinances as of the effective date.
