CBE Reserve Compliance Comments:

Prestige Property Maintenance, Inc. and Royal Regions, Inc. are compliant with the CBE program requirements of the solicitation. The firms did not submit an executed LOI form with the bid package. The firms were given three (3) business days to provide its CBE commitment on the required LOI form. Both firms provided the LOIs within the required three (3) day period.

MCT Service, LLC. and All City Turf, LLC. were given three (3) business days to provide its CBE commitment on the required LOI form or provide documentation demonstrating their good faith efforts to meet the goal in accordance with the Business Opportunity Act of 2012, (the "Act") as amended, Section 1-81.5 (d) (2). The firms did not provide their documentation within the three (3) day period. Therefore, MCT Service, LLC. and All City Turf, LLC. are non-compliant with the CBE program requirements.
